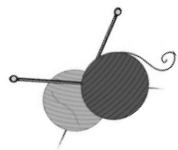


COMMUNITY OUTREACH

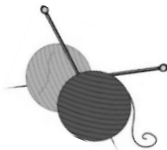

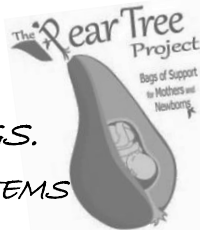

COVID-19 – ST OSWALD'S INFORMATION



